

Perfect Active System Tenses

First, Second, Third, and Fourth Conjugation

Perfect Tense

	Singular	Plural
1 st	-ī (<i>I</i>)	-imus (<i>we</i>)
2 nd	-istī (<i>you</i>)	-istis (<i>you</i>)
3 rd	-it (<i>he</i>)	-erunt/-ēre (<i>they</i>)

Future Perfect Tense

	Singular	Plural
1 st	-erō (<i>I will have</i>)	-erimus (<i>we will have</i>)
2 nd	-eris (<i>you will have</i>)	-eritis (<i>you will have</i>)
3 rd	-erit (<i>he will have</i>)	-erint (<i>they will have</i>)

Pluperfect Tense

	Singular	Plural
1 st	-eram (<i>I had</i>)	-erāmus (<i>we had</i>)
2 nd	-erās (<i>you had</i>)	-erātis (<i>you had</i>)
3 rd	-erat (<i>he had</i>)	-erant (<i>they had</i>)

To find the perfect stem of a verb, drop the **-ī** from the third principle part.
