

Passive Voice of the Present System Tenses

First and Second Conjugation

Present, Future, and Imperfect Tenses

	Singular	Plural
1 st	-r (<i>I</i>)	-mur (<i>we</i>)
2 nd	-ris (<i>you</i>)	-mini (<i>you</i>)
3 rd	-tur (<i>he</i>)	-ntur (<i>they</i>)

To convert an active present system verb into a passive present system verb, the active personal ending is removed and is replaced by the passive personal ending.

Exception: for the first person singular, present and future, the **-r** is added directly to the full active form.

Exception: for the second person singular, future, **-ir-** is changed to **-er-**.

To denote the doer of the action of the passive verb, the ablative of personal agent is used:

PASSIVE VOICE + **ā/ab** /abl./
