2 <sup>nd</sup>	_ eris (vouwillhove)	_ eritis (you will have)
3 <sup>rd</sup>	_ erit (hewillhave)	_ erunt (they will have)

## Pluperfect Tense

-	Singular	Plural
1 <sup>st</sup>	_ eram (I had)	_ erāmus (we had)
2 <sup>nd</sup>	_ <b>erās</b> (you had	)_ <b>erātis</b> (you had)
3 <sup>rd</sup>	_ erat (he had)	<pre>_ erant (they had)</pre>

To find the perfect passive participle stem of a verb, drop the **–um** from the fourth principle part.

Any participle must agree with the subject in number, gender, and case.
