Imperfect Tense

	Singular	Plural
1 <sup>st</sup>	<b>essem</b>	<b>essēmus</b>
2 <sup>nd</sup>	<b>essēs</b>	<b>essētis</b>
3 <sup>rd</sup>	<b>esset</b>	<b>essent</b>

Subjunctive Mood of Possum

Present Tense

	Singular	Plural
1 <sup>st</sup>	<b>possim</b>	<b>possīmus</b>
2 <sup>nd</sup>	<b>possīs</b>	<b>possītis</b>
3 <sup>rd</sup>	<b>possit</b>	<b>possint</b>

Imperfect Tense

	Singular	Plural
1 <sup>st</sup>	<b>possem</b>	<b>possēmus</b>
2 <sup>nd</sup>	<b>possēs</b>	<b>possētis</b>
3 <sup>rd</sup>	<b>posset</b>	<b>possent</b>

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The verb **sum** takes the nominative, not the accusative.
