

## Participles

First, Second, Third, and Fourth Conjugation

	Active	Passive
Pres.	<b>-ns, -ntis</b>	
Perf.		<b>-us, -a, -um</b>
Fut.	<b>-ūrus, -a, -um</b>	<b>-ndus, -a, -um</b>

A participle is an adjective made from a verb.

To find the present active participle, add **-ns, -ntis** to the present stem.

To find the perfect passive participle, add **-us, -a, -um** to the 4<sup>th</sup> principal part.

To find the future active participle, add **-ūrus, -a, -um** to the 4<sup>th</sup> principal part.

To find the future passive participle, add **-ndus, -a, -um** to the present stem.

A participle has number, gender, and case, as well as tense and voice.
